### GREENS SHARES

*(10 weeks, April-June)*

- Reserve me one **Spring Greens Share**. Total cost - \$90. Payments by **April 1**.

### POULTRY SHARES

- Reserve me one **Small Poultry Share** – 25 lb (5-6 birds) **\$132**
- Summer share. August pick-up. Deposit of \$90 due **May 1**. *Balance due at pick-up.*
- Fall share. October pick-up. Deposit of \$90 due **June 15**. *Balance due at pick-up.*
- Reserve me one **Large Poultry Share** – 50# (10-12 birds) **\$263**
- Summer share. August pick-up. Deposit of \$180 due **May 1**. *Balance due at pick-up.*
- Fall share. October pick-up. Deposit of \$180 due **June 15**. *Balance due at pick-up.*

### PASTURE COMBO SHARES

- Small Share**. 20 lb of chicken, 10 lb ground beef, 10 lb pork, 5 lb lamb  
Deposit of \$200 due May 1. *Balance due Oct 1.*  
**Total \$355**
- Large Share**. 40 lb of chicken, 15 lb ground beef, 20 lb pork, 8 lb lamb  
Deposit of \$450 due May 1. *Balance due Oct 1.*  
**Total \$641**

### HALF AND WHOLE ANIMAL SHARES\*

- 1/2 pig (\$5.50/lb per ~105 lb hanging weight) *Deposit of \$400 due May 1.*
- Whole pig (\$5.50/lb per ~210 lb hanging weight) *Deposit of \$800 due May 1.*
- 1/2 beef (\$6/lb per ~105 lb hanging weight) *Deposit of \$400 due May 1.*
- Whole beef (\$6/lb per ~210 lb hanging weight) *Deposit of \$800 due May 1.*
- 1/2 lamb (\$7/lb per ~20 lb hanging weight) *Deposit of \$50 due May 1.*
- Whole lamb (\$7/lb per ~40 lb hanging weight) *Deposit of \$100 due May 1.*
- Small turkey (\$6/lb per 10-17 lb) *Deposit of \$25 due May 1.*
- Large turkey (\$6/lb 18-25 lb) *Deposit of \$25 due May 1.*

*Weights vary, but approximate weights are listed. Cutting and wrapping is included. There is an additional charge for smoking. Balance on shares are due at pickup; pork in October; beef, lamb and turkey in November.*

\*All of our animals are raised on pasture. Our beef and lamb are 100% grass fed. Our chickens, turkeys and pigs have access to organic grain and healthy food scraps. Our pigs also enjoy a tremendous amount of apples and acorns.
